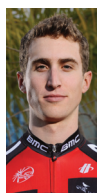

**Philippe Gilbert (BEL)**

Second participation (7th in 2010) ... Only second rider (and first Belgian) to win all three Ardennes classics in one year ... Stage winner at all three Grand Tours.



**Taylor Phinney (USA)**

Second participation (44th in 2010) ... 2011: Won Eneco Tour prologue enroute to fourth place finish overall ... Fifth in Stage 10 time trial at Vuelta a España ... Former World Under 23 time trial champion (2010) and U.S. national time trial champion (2010).



**Thor Hushovd (NOR)**

Second participation (29th in 2003) ... Making BMC Racing Team debut ... 2011: Won two Tour de France stages and wore leader's jersey for seven days ... 2010 world road champion ... Two-time winner of the Tour's points classification (2005, 2009) ... Stage winner at all three Grand Tours.



**Michael Schär (SUI)**

**Martin Kohler (SUI)**

Wore King of the Mountain jersey for two days at first Giro d'Italia.



**Danilo Wyss (SUI)**

**About the BMC Racing Team**

The BMC Racing Team is a United States-registered UCI ProTeam title sponsored by Switzerland-based bicycle manufacturer BMC. The 2012 roster features defending Tour de France champion Cadel Evans and a veteran supporting cast, as well as a host of talented newcomers that includes world No. 1-ranked and Belgian national road and time trial champion Philippe Gilbert. Surrounding them is a host of talent that includes past world road champions Alessandro Ballan and Thor Hushovd, three-time U.S. national road champion George Hincapie, reigning Swiss national time trial champion Martin Kohler, and past national time trial champions Taylor Phinney (U.S.) and Marco Pinotti (Italy). In 2011 – its first season as a ProTeam – the BMC Racing Team won 12 races and finished fifth in the UCI WorldTour team standings. As a pro continental squad in 2010, the team achieved a number of successes, including leading both the Tour de France and the Giro d'Italia in its first participation in both races. The BMC Racing Team was founded in 2006 and is headquartered in Santa Rosa, Calif.
